### Reading your oil tank gauge

It can be a little confusing sometimes to evaluate how much oil you actually have in your oil tank. Usually, there is more oil in it than you think.

The average home burns between 3 - 5 gallons of oil per day. Typically, if you have a 275 gallon tank, a reading of **1/8 full is 40 gallons, 1/4 full is 70 gallons, 1/2 full is 130 gallons, 5/8 full is 160 gallons** and 7/8 full is 240 gallons. So, there is no need to panic.

## Is Your Heating Equipment Outdated?

If your heating equipment is more than 15 years old, it's likely nearing the end of its life-span. Your home's energy efficiency would be greatly improved by replacing an old and inefficient system, regardless of what type of fuel you use to heat your home.
